To be eligible for the scholarship the applicant must:

- Be a member of Journey Federal Credit Union since the beginning of the current calendar year and in good standing.
- Be enrolled as a High School Senior at the time of application.
- Must be accepted/enrolled in an accredited institution and/or working towards their first undergraduate degree.
- Use scholarship funds for tuition or textbooks.

Applicants must submit the entire application packet, a High School transcript, and at least 2 non-relative letters of recommendation to one of the three Journey Federal Credit Union locations by **March 15, 2025** or mail completed application to:

Scholarship winners will be contacted directly and, when applicable, announced at their schools' awards ceremony.
